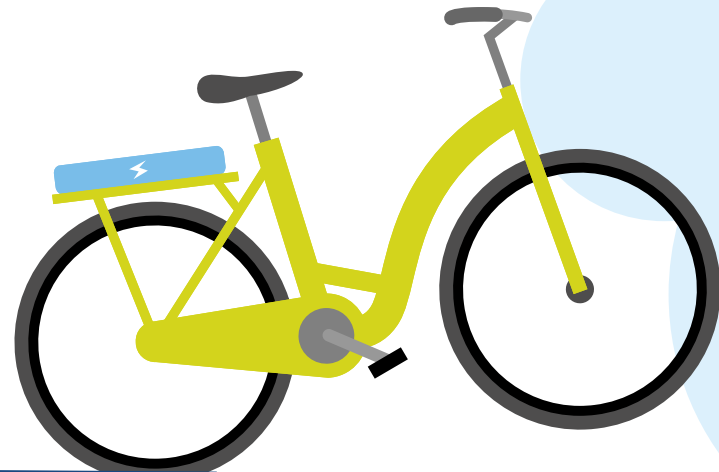

In 2019, (for the second year in a row) more electric bicycles were sold than normal bicycles: a record number of 418 thousand new e-bikes. This is a 19.4-percent increase compared to 2018.

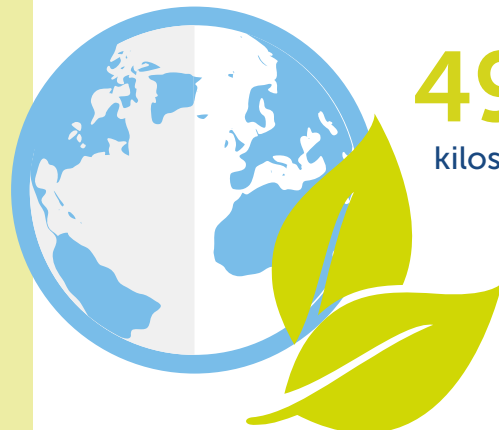

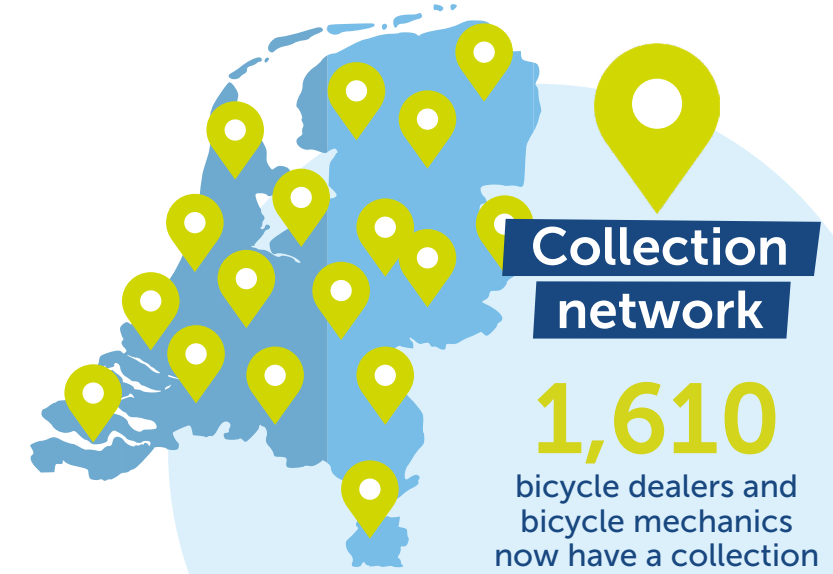

Stichting EPAC offers a collective solution for producers (manufacturers and importers) of e-bikes when it comes to the collection and recycling of e-bike accumulators. On behalf of Stichting EPAC, Stibat takes care of the fulfilment of the statutory manufacturer responsibility. On 31 December 2019, 83 producers of electrical bicycles were affiliated with Stichting EPAC through an accession agreement.
